Her charitable works are numerous, with a long history of serving on non-profit boards as well as funding numerous charitable causes. She and her husband shared part of their lives with two young foster care siblings in the care of DCF.

The Hon. Thomas Lynch **Excellence in Justice Award**

Hon. Retired Judge Mary Rudd Robinson

Judge Mary Rudd Robinson was born and raised in Alamance County, North Carolina. She grew up in an era when the United States went from segregation to desegregation. Her parents as well as her church were always involved in the community and that sense of giving back was instilled in her at an early age. Judge Robinson went to the all Black Pleasant Grove School first through eighth grades

and then helped to desegregate Eastern Alamance High School where she was an Honor student and the school's first Black queen being named Miss Eastern Alamance High School her Senior year. Judge Robinson attended and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where she was the school's first Black female cheerleader. After college, the Judge was hired as the first Recreation Director for the Town of Elon College but eventually gave up that employment to attend law school. She received her Juris Doctorate from North Carolina Central University School of law where she was a member of the Law Review, President of the First year class, Law Day Chairperson and a member of the Region winning Client Counseling team beating out the likes of Duke University, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and University of Virginia to name just a few of the competing universities to win the honor.

Judge Robinson met her husband Michael A. Robinson in law school. She has been a member of the Florida Bar in good standing for forty plus years. She started her legal career as a staff attorney for Legal Aid of Broward County as a Family law attorney. From there she became Broward County's first Black General Magistrate, a position she held for four and a half years before becoming the County's first Black female judge. At the time of her appointment in 1989, Judge Robinson was only the fourth Black female judge in the history of state of the Florida. Needless to say, there have been a lot of firsts in the Judge's life. Judge Robinson served in the criminal division of the County Court where she was the Chief Administrative Judge for the Criminal Division. She is active in her community serving or having served on numerous Community and Charitable Boards and as a mentor. She is a long-time member of the New Mount Olive Baptist Church, Life member of the NAACP, Life member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., member of the Links, Incorporated, member of the National Bar Association and its affiliate Florida chapter as well as being a current trustee of the Florida Supreme Court Historical Society. She is also a member and/or supporter of several HBCU Alumni associations, and these are just some of her affiliations. Judge Robinson has received numerous awards including but not limited to the T. J. Reddick Bar Association Trailblazer award, National Association of Negro and Professional Women's Woman of the Year, Dr. J.P. Sistrunk Outstanding Achievement award, African American Research Library Community Service and Distinguished Achievement award and she was named as one of South Florida's Most Distinguished and Influential Black Women of 2010 by Success Florida Magazine. She is a recent recipient of the T.J. Reddick Bar Association and the Florida Virgil Hawkins Chapter of the NBA Legacy Awards. These are only a few of her accomplishments. Judge Robinson retired from the County Bench, Broward County in 2016 after over thirty-two years of service. Judge Robinson is married to Fort Lauderdale native, Michael A. Robinson, now a Circuit Court Judge in Broward County and they have three beautiful daughters. Her philosophy is the same as that of her mentor, the late Margaret Blake Roach, that we are placed on this earth to serve.
